Graduation Requirements and Sample Schedule

6 period day = 24 credits over 4 years

(6) 50 minute periods

Language Arts - 4 credits (MN=4)

Math - 3 credits (MN=3) Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry

Science - 3 credits (MN=3) Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics

Social Studies - 3.5 credits (MN=3.5) U.S. History, geography, world history, economics

Bible/Worldview - 4 credits

PE - .5 credits *

Health - .5 credits

Fine Arts - 1 credit (MN=1) *

Finance - .5 credits

Public Speaking - .5 credits

Typing/Computer - .5 credits

Electives - 3-4 credits (possible 4 more elective credits over 4 years as a separate purchase - additional credits will be \$610 each through iLumened)

total=21.5 credits (or 28 depending on elective choices)

* will be completed outside of normal school hours

Italicized - optional but highly recommended

Courses listed are minimum. Please note, if a student is planning on attending a 4 year college - they should look at what coursework is recommended in high school.

Typically a student should look at adding 2 credits of a foreign language, an additional math course and an additional science course. Students will be able to fine tune their own classes/schedules when meeting with the Assistant Principal as well as making use of the iLumened guidance counselor.
